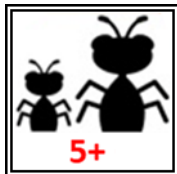




NumBugz[®] Rules



Bondz



A quick maths game designed to help learn number bonds

Aim of the game: To create 6 number Bondz that add up to 10 or 20

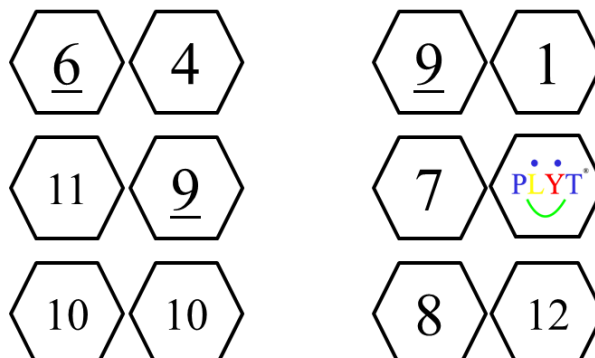
Players: Can be played by 1 to 6 people

Starting the game: Place all the Bugz, Bug face up, on the table. All players flip a Bug onto its number side at the same time (and keep that Bug in their nest). The player with the highest number goes first.

Playing the game: Players take it in turns, in a clockwise order, to take one Bug from the table, flip it into their nest and try to make Bondz up to 10 or 20 (ie. any 2 numbers that add together to make 10 or 20). A player can have no more than 12 Bugz in their nest at any one time – when they reach 12, to continue playing they must swap one Bug from their nest with one on the table. A PLYT Bug can be any number you want from 1 to 13.

Winning the game: The first player to complete 6 number Bondz wins the game.

Tip: When players swap Bugz from their nest, keep a close eye on what they put back on the table because it might be what you need
